

## What is COP28?

COP is the <u>United Nations Climate Change Conference</u>. It takes place annually. It is the largest conference of its kind with over 200 nations in attendance. The climate crisis is addressed with actions to follow, such as achieving net-zero emissions by 2050.

#### Results


The world's first climate action "global stocktake" to achieve the global temperature limit of 1.5°C.






Over 200 nations pledged to transition away from fossil fuels to renewables such as wind and solar power.

Six countries pledged new funding at COP28 to the Green Climate Fund bringing up pledges to USD 12.8 billion.





Historic agreement to operationalise a loss and damage fund for vulnerable nations to improve climate resilience.





## COP28 We are the Possible between UK & UAE

We are the Possible We are the Possible is an international collaboration addressing policymakers and the public over the importance of science, health, education, and the arts to engage people about climate change and enable them to see that they have agency to make a difference. It is centred around two bilingual poetry anthologies (Arabic & English) brought to life through theatre performances, music, animations, schools across the ocean programme and more.

## **COP27 We Still Have a Chance**

We Still Have a Chance brought together 150 climate scientists, health professionals, youth activists, artists, and storytellers from the UK and Egypt in a series of virtual creative writing workshops resulting in 12 short stories written in Arabic and English.

#### **COP26 One Chance Left**

One Chance Left is a project that highlights links between the climate crisis and human health. The poems connect a mix of voices from climate science and healthcare, using words to halt and heal a fast-escalating climate emergency.
