# Recycling Bin



## For recyclable materials:

- Paper
- Cardboard
- Plastic bottles and containers
- Aluminium cans and tins
- Plastic milk pints
- Cartons
- Envelopes

# Glass Bin



## For glass materials:

- Bottles (wine, beer)
- Jars (sauce, jam)
- Broken glassware  
(ensure safety measures)

# Food Waste Bin



## For specific food waste:

- Leftover food
- Expired food
- Small bones
- Dairy products
- Bread and bakery items

# Cardboard Bin



## For cardboard materials:

- Cardboard boxes (flattened)
- Cardboard packaging (clean and dry)
- Corrugated cardboard
- Cereal boxes (remove plastic liners)

# Rubbish Bin



## For non-recyclable and non-compostable waste:

- Polystyrene
- Broken crockery & glass
- Tissue paper & blue roll
- Rope
- Takeaway containers
- Styrofoam
- Crisp packets & food wrappers
- (Some) Soft plastics



# Weee Bin



## For electrical & electronics:

- Small appliances with plugs
- IT equipment
- Cables
- Printer toners
